

A little bit of KANC history

84 years have passed since Ann Ewing Smith set out to develop a business group to offer services to those new in the community. The A.E.S Hostess Service would serve as a personalized advertising business she could offer to new residents in Kalamazoo. Quickly discovering the women she encountered had a need to socialize and form friendships with other women and young mothers, the hostess service served as a catalyst for the KANC. For the first 30-plus years, the group partnered with the YWCA, utilizing the organization's downtown building as a meeting place, as

well as for services such as child care. As more women entered the workforce, the group grew to its peak membership of 400-plus members in the 1970s when it severed ties with the YWCA and became an independent nonprofit focused on the needs of women in the community
